

Appraisal Institute Chapters' Position Statement

The Appraisal Institute Chapters are aware that the Strategic Planning Committee is developing Chapter and/or Region governance restructure recommendations for consideration by the National Board of Directors.

The Strategic Planning Committee has been working on these recommendations for an extended period of time. The normal 45-day notice, in all probability, would be insufficient for Chapters, Regions and AI professionals to gain a knowledgeable understanding of all potential implications and issues as a result of the recommendations. Ample time and resources must be allocated for Chapters, Regions and AI professionals to fully review any proposed recommendations, in accordance with best practices standards. Therefore, the below signed Chapters hereby request that:

- 1) Any proposal or recommendation in any form, character or name, which proposal or recommendation is intended to change or modify the methods or processes by which Chapters maintain and manage their finances, shall be presented to Chapters and the AI professionals for their review, consideration and input no less than 90 days prior to a vote by any board, committee or panel of the Appraisal Institute. Chapter finances could include, but are not limited to, establishing, maintaining and managing bank accounts, depositing funds, processing invoices for payment and any revisions in Region finances or payments that alter Chapter income or expenses.
- 2) Any proposal or recommendation in any form, character or name, which proposal or recommendation is intended to impact the governance structure as it relates to Chapters and/or Regions, shall be presented to AI professionals, Chapters and Regions for their review, consideration and input no less than 90 days prior to a vote by any board, committee or panel of the Appraisal Institute.
